How Accessible is this website

We know some parts of this website are not fully accessible, including:

- Some PDF documents are not fully accessible (e.g., scanned minutes/agendas)
- Some pages may contain heading structure issues
- Some images may be missing meaningful alternative text
- Colour contrast may not meet WCAG 2.2 AA on certain banner elements
- Some older documents may not meet HTML or tagging standards

These issues are being reviewed as part of our 2026 accessibility improvement.

What We're Doing to Improve Accessibility

We are:

- Replacing scanned PDFs with accessible, text-based versions
- Ensuring all new documents meet accessibility standards
- Reviewing contrast, headings, and alt text across the website
- Testing pages with automated tools (WAVE, Silktide) and manual checks

- Introducing training for staff on creating accessible content
