Ashby Road, Donisthorpe – Donisthorpe Primary School

Leicestershire County Council proposes to introduce **additional mandatory "School Keep Clear" markings** outside Donisthorpe Primary School on Ashby Road.

Restriction:

- Monday to Friday
- 8:00am to 5:00pm

Reason given by the County Council:

- To improve safety for school children.
- To highlight areas that should be kept clear during school drop-off and collection times.
- To improve safety for all road users.

The proposal does **not** introduce parking charges or wider waiting restrictions. It simply extends the existing school safety markings outside the school.

The consultation finishes before the Council sits again.
