Oakthorpe, Donisthorpe and Acresford Parish Council Report - 12th March 2025

Councillor Warren has done a wonderful display of the memorial plaques that were saved from Acresford Church before it was sold.

The plaques are now on display in Acresford Memorial Gardens.

As we are aware, accidents and speeding are a issue in the

Parish. So I thought I'd share the most recent report from the speed sign while it was on Acresford Road, Donisthorpe.

ODAPC has three speed monitors which are moved quarterly by volunteers and /or Councillors.

The monitors are to remind drivers of the speed limit, they are in 30mph zones.

Acresford Road Donisthorpe - 30 limit

Average Speed - 31.9 mph

Max speed - 65mph on 07/11/24 @ 08.20am

Total vehicles - 99,435

AADT (Annual Average Daily Traffic) - 1,152

Percentage over 30mph - 52%, averaging 36.2 mph

This information is discussed at ODAPC meetings, but decisions about traffic calming and enforcement rest with the Police and County Council.

As we can see, there is a staggering 52% over the 30mph speed limit. If anyone would like to volunteer for Speed Watch, please contact a Parish Council member so we can run speed watch days. We can't without the help of volunteers.




