In the UK, a parish council does not need to obtain approval from parishioners to change the name of the parish. The Local Government Act 1972 allows a parish council to change the name of the parish at their discretion, without the need for a formal vote or consultation process. This change can be made under Section 75 of the Act, which states that the Council of the District in which the parish is situated may change the name of the parish.
